

General EPUB Documentation

An EPUB is an e-book that can be downloaded and read on your smartphone, tablet, or computer. E-book readers exist for all major hardware platforms, including free readers such as iBooks for iOS and Google Play Books for Android. (Note that Amazon Kindle e-readers cannot read the EPUB file format.)

To read the EPUB version of the *Proceedings of the 2015 Conference on Autonomous and Robotic Construction of Infrastructure* (the Proceedings) on your device, first download either iBooks, Google Play Books, or any other preferred e-reader to your device. After the e-reader is installed, download the EPUB to your device. Some browsers will open the EPUB automatically upon download. Or, you may receive a prompt asking what application you would like to view the EPUB in. Select your e-reader. Your e-reader application should open and display the Proceedings. If not, you will need to open your e-reader and select the Proceedings from the list of e-books in your library.

If you're new to e-books, *experiment with the functions*. You can electronically bookmark pages, "highlight" text, change the font size for easier reading, double-tap the graphics to zoom in on the details, and link from the table of contents to specific sections of the document.
